**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY THE PLANNING, ENVIRONMENTAL  
MANAGEMENT AND REAL PROPERTY COMMITTEE TO AUTHORIZE  
CONTRACTS FOR THE 2018 SULLIVAN SIGNS PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Sullivan County Legislature allocated \$75,000 in the FY 2018 budget to be distributed to Sullivan County municipalities through the Sullivan Signs program for enhancing the County's image, contributing to a sense of place, and improving visitor experiences with new and updated welcome, wayfinding and historical marker signage; and

**WHEREAS**, the program review committee assessed recent applications and presented its recommendations to the Sullivan County Legislature;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Sullivan County Legislature approves the projects listed in the attached Schedule A and the disbursement of the associated funds, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Sullivan County Legislature authorizes the County Manager to enter into contracts with these municipalities for the projects listed, said contracts to be in a form approved by the County Attorney.

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY PLANNING, ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT & REAL PROPERTY COMMITTEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GOOGLE MAPS TO PROVIDE STREET AND ADDRESS DATA.**

**WHEREAS**, Google Maps, a web mapping service developed by Google LLC, provides digital maps that are available for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, information within these maps include street and address data; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency service providers within Sullivan County will sometimes use Google Maps to locate an address; and

**WHEREAS**, the street and address data within Google Maps does not always accurately reflect the County-maintained street and address database; and

**WHEREAS**, Sullivan County Real Property Tax Services recommends that the County enter into an agreement with Google LLC allowing Google LLC to use the County's digital street and address data to update Google Maps.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Google LLC for the purpose of updating Google Maps with the County's digital street and address data;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the form of said agreement shall be approved by the County Attorney.
